



## COL D'ORCIA ROSSO DI MONTALCINO

*Col d'Orcia is the feted producer of one of Italy's most revered red wines: Brunello di Montalcino. Situated near the medieval hilltop village of Montalcino in Tuscany's Siena province, the estate has a rich winemaking history that dates back to the 1700s. In the hands of the Cinzano family since 1973, Col d'Orcia is owned by Count Francesco Marone Cinzano, who oversees day-to-day operations with estate manager, Edoardo Virano.*

*Winemaking is entrusted to chief enologist Pablo Harri, whom many contemporary wine experts credit with being Tuscany's foremost expert in the art of making outstanding Brunello di Montalcino wines.*

### PRODUCTION TECHNIQUES

Grapes ferment on the skins for twelve days at a controlled temperature of less than 28°C. The wine is aged for nine months, partially in new French oak barriques and partially in Slavonian oak casks, followed by additional refinement in the bottle prior to release.

### DESCRIPTION

**Color:** Deep ruby red with purple reflections  
**Aroma:** Fresh, intense aromas of ripe fruit infused with spice from the oak  
**Taste:** Full-bodied and fruit forward, structured by supple tannins

### ANALYSIS

Alc.: 13.4%

### SERVING SUGGESTIONS

Serve slightly cooler than room temperature. Well-matched with veal, pork and poultry dishes, as well as duck and goose.
