PRODUCTION TECHNIQUES

Manual harvesting starts in mid-October and lasts until early November. After pressing, a long maceration on the skins takes place. Once malolactic fermentation is completed, the wine is aged for 18 months in new French oak barrels prior to release.

DESCRIPTION

Color: Ruby red

Aroma: Intense, persistent bouquet of rich wild cherries, toasted oak and warm vanilla

Taste: Soft, dense and well balanced; long and pleasant finish, with flavors of red berries against a smooth background of toast and spice
