



MARCHESI DI BAROLO BAROLO

One of the great names in Piedmontese winemaking, Marchesi di Barolo dates back to the 12th century, when the land-owning Falletti family of Piedmont's Barolo district was awarded titles of nobility. Today the estate owns about 100 acres of vineyard in the Langhe, including some of the finest vineyards in the district. Marchesi di Barolo has been owned since 1929 by the Abbona family, who make their home in the large, yellow-fronted villa overlooking the picturesque village of Barolo. Like their Falletti predecessors the Abbonas are committed to conserving the estate's time-honored reputation.

AGING

Aged 2-3 years in a combination of small, new and older, used Slavonian oak casks. The wine is further aged six months in bottle prior to release. It can be cellared for 15-20 years.

A perfect complement to red meats and ripe cheeses. Serve at a moderate room temperature.
